Partner Spotlights

one2one - Zero Mass Water Nationwide Initiative

Would it surprise you to know that twenty-one million U.S. residents do not have reliable access to safe water, including mining-ravaged Appalachia and places like Flint, Michigan? We are excited to announce our partnership with **Zero Mass Water**, a tech startup that creates Hydropanels that produce water using just sunlight and air. A few weeks ago, one2one Donors stepped in to fund the installation of 24 Hydropanels at a local food bank in Kimball, WV, helping to secure a source for clean, safe water for the approximately 150 families served by the food bank who are desperate for it. These panels can produce the equivalent of up to 7,200 standard 16.9oz bottles of water every month, and over its 15-year life will offset over 1.3 million single-use plastic water bottles that would have cost over \$160,000 and had a negative effect on the environment.

one2one unveiled the Hydropanel installation with a community event at the **Five Loaves & Two Fishes Food Bank** this past Saturday, November 15th. one2one is committed to making an impact on the water problem not just in West Virginia, but in many similar communities across the United States. We truly believe we have a charitable solution that is economical, long-lasting and eco-friendly. Nine-year-old Myleanna's leg was amputated from the knee down after a lawn mower accident in 2017. Spirited, athletic and with a “can-do” attitude, Myleanna continued her favorite activities; dancing, gymnastics and soccer using a bulky, uncomfortable prosthetic leg which was not conducive to high impact activity. Unfortunately, the lightweight prosthetic blade better suited for sports and activities was expensive and not covered by insurance. We matched our generous Donor with **A Step Ahead Prosthetics** enabling Myleanna to receive a high performance blade and continue her activities.

Hearing of this touching story, the Clearwater Marine Aquarium in Florida invited the family for an all-expense paid VIP meet and greet visit where Myleanna was able to live out her dream of meeting Winter, a dolphin with a prosthetic tail.



Siga's Story

Siga, the daughter of a Malawian immigrant and the oldest of three siblings being raised by a single mother, recently met the couple donating money towards her four-year education at **Tulane University**. With the help of her donors and the one2one USA Foundation, Siga is able to pursue her dream of becoming a neurosurgeon, inspired by her brother's battle with a neurological disorder.
